Future Leader Fellowship: Overview

For ECRs and innovators transitioning to or establishing independence

You must clearly demonstrate:

- how the FLF award will support and enable your long-term career goals
- broad knowledge of the area of interest and vision for its importance
- your own original and ambitious plans/ideas and can take a leading role in your area
- the suitability of the proposed environment(s)



FLF: Who can apply?

There is no limit on years since PhD

No requirement to hold a PhD for those applying from business, but need to demonstrate equivalent research/innovation experience and/or training

Call spans all areas of UKRI remit including multiand interdisciplinary projects

Supportive of diverse career paths





FLF: Funding

Awards are made for up to 7 years (funded for 4 with option to extend for further 3)

No limit to amount of requested funding but must be justified

Fellowship will provide salary support, equipment, T&S, estate costs etc.





BBSRC Discovery Fellowship



Discovery Fellowship: Overview

Provide support for researchers wishing to undertake independent research

Applicants must have completed a successful PhD viva

You must show you:

- have potential to become a future research leader
- wish to conduct your own independent research within a host lab
- wish to gain leadership skills







DF: Who can apply?

There is no limit on the number of years of postdoc experience

Applicants must **not** have held a post of lecturer level or an equivalent competitive Fellowship that provides the opportunity to:

- supervise PhD students
- establish an independent research group

Applicants **can't** have applied for BBSRC grant funding as a PI or Co-Investigator



DF: Funding

Awards are made for 3 years

Funding can support:

- Personal salary, T&S, training activities and research consumables
- NOT equipment





DF – Application Process

Apply through Je-S

• Pass application to host institute for submission in advance of deadline!

Pro forma

- Choice of host institute
- Objectives/technical summary/summary
- Academic beneficiaries
- Commercial exploitation/application (if applicable)
- Resources requested







DF – Application Process

- Case for support
- CV
- Justification of resources
- Head of department statement (support)
- Statement from host group PI
- Workplan (Gantt chart)
- Data management plan
- Career development plan



Eligibility and scientific remit

DF – Assessment Process



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- External experts assess scientific content of research project – rebuttals!
- Candidates are selected for interview by Committee E
- Approx. 1/3 applicants invited to interview are expected to be successful



DF – Assessment criteria

Project

- Scientific quality and feasibility of research
- Timeliness of research and how it will advance the field

Person

- Track record
- Evidence of independence and leadership
- How the fellowship will advance the applicant's career



DF – Assessment criteria

Research environment

- Scientific environment of host department and institute
- Evidence of career and professional development support
- Evidence of research support



DF – Scoring

1-6 scoring range (unfundable to exceptional)

Exceptional applicant

 "Applicant who, for their career stage, has clearly demonstrated very strong credentials as an independent researcher and is already recognised as being a future leader within their field."

Exceptional research programme

 "Applicant is proposing a scientific project that is timely and which is expected to allow the candidate to establish themselves as a leader in the field and provide scope for future research directions."



DF – Scoring

Exceptional research environment

• "The proposed **research environment** is **fully justified** as being the **best place** in which to carry out the research, and there is a **clear commitment** from the **host institution** to support the candidate."



Features of an excellent application

- Evidence of career progression/trajectory;
- Evidence of outputs or markers of esteem;
- Evidence of **strong** support from Host PI and RO;
- Evidence of how the research programme is going to advance the field



Basically **EVIDENCE!**

Moving forwards

Seek advice

- Institute research office
- Research council

But carefully manage this advice

• Not all advice is good, accurate or reflect current realities
